

# What can I put in the plastic recycling bin?

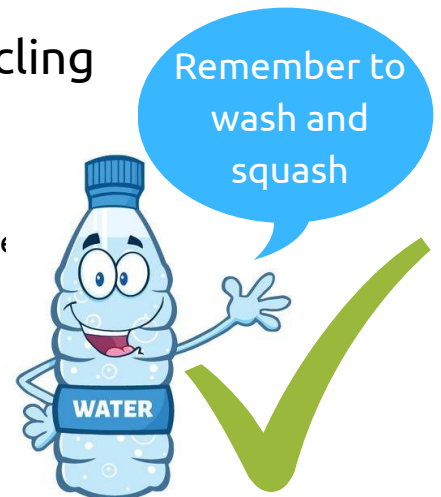
Check the packaging for these symbols



## Is your item a plastic bottle?

These items can be put in the plastic recycling

- All clear and coloured plastic bottles from around the home
- Detergent and soap bottles (minus the pump)
- Cleaning product bottles (e.g. bathroom cleaners, bleach) (Triggers can be left on)
- Skin care product bottles
- Shampoo and shower gel bottles
- Fizzy and non-fizzy drinks and water bottles
- Milk bottles
- Ready-to-use plant food and pesticides bottles (check the label)



## Is your item a plastic bag?

These items can be dropped off at carrier bag collection points

- All plastic bags, except biodegradable or compostable bags
- Bread bags
- Breakfast cereal liners
- Shrink wrap & ring joiners from multipacks of water, cans etc
- Frozen food bags, e.g. bags for frozen vegetable, chips, etc
- Dry cleaning bags/bags covering new clothing
- Magazine and newspaper wrappers
- Bags for fruit and vegetables
- Bubble wrap
- Low-density polyethylene (LDPE) - resin ID code 4



## These items can not be put in the plastic recycling

- Any non-Polyethylene film (e.g. PP, PVC, others)
- Cling film
- Food and drink pouches
- Wrappers from bakeries, e.g. bags with lots of small holes in them
- Film lids from trays and pots, e.g. yoghurt pots
- Any dirty bags or film, for example containing food
- Crisp packets
- Compostable bags
- Any film claiming to be biodegradable
- Pre-prepared salad bags
- black plastic trays (unless marked recyclable)
